



Apps Gone Free is both a webpage and an app available for your iPad.

The app allows users to access high quality paid apps for free each day. This is a human-curated list of free apps each day. Each of the free apps must have a 3 star or better iTunes rating, normally cost, and don't include outside ads. Daily lists are generated around 12:00 EST. Please remember that these apps are not education specific. Many of the apps available are used to increase productivity or for enjoyment.

The app version can be found in the iTunes store and downloaded for free. The app has received a five-star rating from over 12,000 customer votes. Once the app is downloaded from the iTunes store, tap it to open and access the days deals. If you look along the left side of the screen, you can see the apps that were available as previous deals. Sometimes these apps may remain free for longer than one day. So, if your time allows, take a look at previous day's deals.

From the home page look under the heading of Latest App News for the posting of "Today's Apps Gone Free" titles. It will be listed in this section of the page.

Visitors can click on that link and it will take them to the full posting listing the available free apps along with a link to the app in the iTunes store, normal price, required space, ratings based on the five- star scale and a brief description of the app.



*Please note that some apps are available as iPhone only. On the webpage the apps are separated by iPhone, iPad, and Universal – meaning they will work for either.
