Creating an iTunes Store Account without a Credit Card

- 1. Restart your device. (Just trust us.)
- 2. Open the App Store on your device.
- 3. Find a free application on the App Store.
- 4. <u>Important</u>: Before proceeding to the next step, you must begin to download and install the free application by tapping **Free** followed by tapping **Install**.



5. Tap Create New Apple ID.



6. Choose your country, and then tap **Next**.

- 8. Enter your email address, security questions, birthday, and create your password.
- Apple recommends that you add a rescue email address, but it is optional. However, we do *NOT* recommend that you do this because there could be problems if you try to look up your password. Please skip putting in a rescue email address.
- 10. Once you are satisfied with the information entered, tap Next.
- 11. Select **None** as your payment option.
